- **No new action was taken on the OSHA mandated 2-man crew issue**
- **Committee is watching a bill authorizing Counties to establish fees for certain ordinance violations.**

- **Committee opposes Assembly Bill 1005, which requires Department of Consumer Affairs to conduct analysis of the languages offered for profession licenses.**
- **Committee opposes Senate Bill 2 Building Jobs and Home act which establishes a fee of 75.00 for each property transaction.**
- **Committee favors Senate Bill 436 establishing STEM teaching pathway education.**
- **Committee opposes Senate Bill 640 broadening tax base by taxing professional services.**

V. OLD BUSINESS

Steve Dean reported that the Trinity County recorder was still overcharging for recorded maps.

Frank Lehmann presented draft changes of the Shasta County Fire Standards that extends the length of dead end roads to a mile.

VI. New Business

Retired membership status bylaws was presented and discussed. Ron Nelms was asked to investigate a possible state involvement requirement.

Frank Lehman moved that the Cascade Chapter draft a letter to the Central Office that supports CLSA participation in the 2018 Joint Survey Conference in Las Vegas with the Western Federation of Professional Surveyors, and the Nevada, Arizona and Utah associations. Steve Dean seconded and the motion carried.
